Conditions of Charter

1. SUPERVISION

A. In order to make a tentative reservation on any boat and proceed with your booking, All Occasion Cruises requires the name, contact number and email address of your parent or guardian.

2. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

A. All Occasion Cruises is a licensed venue and has conditions of entry – you are forbidden to carry any alcohol or illegal substances onto the boat. We reserve the right to refuse you entry onto the boat or require you to disembark from the boat due to intoxication or for the safety of other guests on board. Tickets will not be refunded under any of these circumstances.

B. Security

Security guards have the right to bag search, Search and Seize, or report you to police if they suspect you are carrying illegal substances or alcohol. If you are found under the influence or in possession of alcohol or illegal substance they will be confiscated and you must disembark immediately, your parents will be informed and you may be referred to NSW State Police.

C. Breath-Testing

Random compulsory breath-testing may apply prior to boarding. A strict zero tolerance policy applies in accordance with NSW State Law. If you refuse to comply, you will not be allowed to board the boat. If guests are behaving in a disorderly manner or suspect that guests are under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs staff and security guards reserve the right to cancel the cruise at any time.

The above conditions of entry are for the safety of all passengers. Don't Try It, It Won't Work!

D. We reserve the right, if considered necessary (due to mechanical breakdown, for safety reasons, weather conditions or extreme unforeseen circumstances), to substitute boats without notice (including any boats of a third party), change menu items or cruise details and schedules. We will endeavour to provide a similar quality boat, menu, service, schedule/ program or performance in these circumstances.

3. CANCELLATIONS

In the event that your function is cancelled or postponed, the booking deposit is non-refundable. Cancellations 30 days prior to your event will result in 25% of the booking fee being invoiced. Cancellations made 14 days prior to the booking date will result in 50% of the cruise cost being invoiced. Dispute resolution is encouraged and your Event Manager or Management can be contacted should cancellations occur.

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4. HEALTH AND SAFETY

All Occasion Cruises accepts no responsibility for any injury caused to patrons while on their boats, pertaining to the sudden movement of the Harbour swell or when embarking or disembarking the boat on any public or private wharves. All guests are required to demonstrate a basic level of caution while present on a moving boat.

5. PAYMENT DETAILS:

A. Cruise Deposit

From the time you request a tentative hold for a boat, date and time, a \$1,000 deposit is required within 14 days. **The deposit will be deducted from your final balance owing.** If the deposit payment is not received during this time, your boat, date and time may be allocated to another party at the decision of management.

B. Progress Payments

If your cruise spend is over the value of \$10,000, progress payments are required in intervals leading up to your event, as specified by your event organiser.

C. Final Payment

All quotations are based on a **MINIMUM** number of guests. Payment of your agreed minimum is required 14 days prior to the charter date. Payment for additional guests above the agreed minimum must be paid 7 days prior to the charter.

D. Wharf Fees

State Government wharf fees apply to all wharves on Sydney Harbour and are \$50.00 for each berthing, addition to per person price. The allocated time at your selected wharf is 15 minutes.

E. Payment Methods

We accept payment by direct transfer, cash or credit card. All credit cards incur a 2.5% surcharge. Payments made by direct deposit will require a remittance to be sent to your event coordinator.

6. CHARTER FINALISATION

A. Your final guest numbers and cruise details are to be finalised 14 days prior to your charter with your event coordinator. This includes itinerary, final guest numbers, seating plan, deliveries, dietary requirements and supplier contact details. No changes will be accepted after this 14 day period.

B. All reasonable measures will be taken to ensure dietary requirements and allergies are adequately catered for. All Occasion Cruises operate a commercial kitchen and recommend an appropriate level of caution from guests with allergies when ingesting any food items.
