SALUTE TO AUSTRALIA (11.30AM-12.05PM)

The event features HMAS Canberra on the water, a 21-gun salute on land and RAAF fast jets flying in formation above Sydney Harbour. Watch a graceful company of yachts, tugboats, jet-skis and ferries glide in precision across the water, accompanied by helicopters above, in an epic piece of musical magic.
